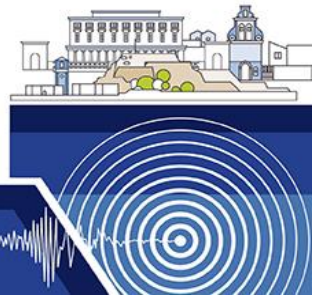

Although its activities started earlier, the EMSC was founded in Strasbourg in 1984 as a non-profit association under French law. These 50 years of activity have seen major changes, the first being the move in 1993 from the University of Strasbourg and the Earth Observatory to the Laboratoire de Détection et Géophysique, CEA, in Bruyères le Châtel. Over the last 5 decades, thanks to the support of its members and data contributors, and its participation in many research projects, it has continuously developed its services, from earthquake monitoring to citizen seismology, making the EMSC one of the most important information centres on earthquakes and their effects.

In this session we welcome contributions on the history of the EMSC, its developments, past and present projects it has been involved in, collaborations, examples of use of its services and data, as well as policy and future development discussions.
